Please complete the following checklist to determine submittal requirements and fees (check all that apply):

- The property is in the Rural Residential Zone District.
- The fence is entirely within the property boundaries. (Fences cannot be within a Town right-of-way.)
- The fence is located within 50 feet of the closest edge of a Town right-of-way. (**Any fence located within 50 feet of the closest edge of the Town right-of-way must be 70% or more open. Chain link is not allowed.**)
- The fence is less than 70% open and located within 50 feet of a property line not adjacent to a Town right-of-way. (Requires engineering review.)
- The fence is less than 70% open and is not within 50 feet of a Town right-of-way or a property line
- The fence is located more than 50' from any property line.
- The fence is in a drainageway. (Requires engineering review.)
- The fence does not exceed 6 feet in height measured as the vertical distance from existing grade, or the grade of an approved overlot grading plan, to the top of the fence. Columns are not included in determining the height of the fence so long as the height of the column is not more than two (2) feet greater than the applicable height limitation for the fence.
- The fence is constructed on top of a berm. (The height of the fence and the berm shall be the sum of the individual parts.)
- The fence shall enclose the immediate area of a tennis or sport court. (Must be open and not exceed 10 feet in height.)
- The fence shall be constructed of materials designed or specified to be used for such purpose. The use of barbed wire fences is not permitted. Proposed material(s): \_\_\_\_\_

**THE FOLLOWING APPLICATIONS REQUIRE REVIEW BY THE TOWN ENGINEER:**

- The fence is in a drainageway. Installation of fences will be allowed in and/or perpendicular to drainageways only if such structures do not impede the flow of drainage and are constructed to minimize the collection of debris that could block the drainage flows.
- The fence is less than 70% open and within 50 feet of a property line not adjacent to Town right-of-way.

**FENCES THAT DO NOT REQUIRE A PERMIT:**

- Moveable or temporary riding rings.
- Fences constructed of netting, chicken wire and similar light-weight material, to protect vegetation and gardens from wildlife.
- Construction fences, for the duration of an approved building or overlot grading permit.
- Wire attached to the inside of a permitted open fence provided that the material does not cause the fence to become less than 70% open.

**SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Completed Application Form
2. A copy or sketch of a concept site plan, Improvement Location Certificate (ILC) or survey showing property boundaries (property lines), rights-of-way, drainageways, easements and the proposed location of the fence on the property (use reverse side or provide attachment).
