**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-3-10 OF THE
FOXFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW
SUBSECTION (f) PERTAINING TO THE PROCESS OF ISSUING
SPECIAL EVENT PERMITS**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
FOXFIELD, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 6-3-10 of the Foxfield Municipal Code is amended by the addition
thereto of a new subsection (f) to read as follows:


(f) Pursuant to Section 12-48-107(4) C.R.S, the Town Clerk shall be authorized to issue
special event permits administratively. The Authority shall cause a hearing to be held if,
after investigation and upon review of the contents of the application by the Town Clerk
or of any protest filed by affected persons, sufficient grounds appear to exist for denial of
a permit. Any protest shall be filed by affected persons within ten (10) days after the date
of notice pursuant to section 12-48-106 (2) C.R.S. Any hearing shall be held at least ten
(10) days after the initial posting of the notice, and notice thereof shall be provided the
applicant and any person who has filed a protest.

Section 2. The Town Board of Trustees hereby finds, determines, and declares that
this ordinance is promulgated under the general police powers of the Town of Foxfield, that it is
promulgated for the health, safety, and welfare of the public, and that this ordinance is necessary
for the preservation of health and safety and for the protection of public convenience and
welfare. The Board of Trustees further determines that the ordinance bears a rational relation to
the proper legislative object sought to be attained.

Section 3. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, or part of this ordinance or the
application thereof to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of
competent jurisdiction invalid, such judgment shall not affect application to other persons or
circumstances.


Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after final
publication.


